Ye Zhizheng, famous sedimentologist, marine geologist and geological educationist; academician, the Academia Sinica; born in 1918; graduated from Central University in 1941, Nanjing gained M. S. degree in Missouri University (1948), U. S. A.; ex-professor, chairman of department of marine geology and dean of studies, Changchun College of Geology; ex-president, Nanjing Institute of Geology and Mineral Resources and Qingdao Institute of Marine Geology, Ministry of Geology & Mineral Resources of China; ex-chairman of the board, Chinese Marine Geological Society; honorary president, Nanjing Institute of Geology and Mineral Resources; director, Research Centre of the Quaternary Geology, Ministry of Geology and Mineral Resources of China; honorary chairman of the board, Chinese Marine Geological Society; vice president, Commission of Sedimentary Geology of Geological Society of China; member, the standing committee of Chinese Oceanology Society; chief editor of Marine Geology & Quaternary Geology and vice chief editor of Acta Sedimentolgica Sinica; part-time professor of Department of Marine Geology, Tongii University, and part-time professor of Department of Geo and Ocean Science and department of the Earth Sciences, Nanjing University; supervisor of Ph. D. students; senior technical consultant of the Bureau of Guangzhou Marine Survey; standing member CPPCC, Jiangsu Commitee; national correspondent the International Association of Sedimentologists; board member, the International Geological Correlation Programme.

Professor Ye Zhizheng dedicates his life to the causes and undertakings of the geological education and research of sedimentary geology and Marine geology and is the founder of Sedimentary geology and marine geology of new China.
